

Some of the initiatives relevant for VET

- New VET strategy in 2026 for attractiveness, excellence and inclusion of VET as well as its internationalization
 - Report on implementation of 2020 VET CR (end 2025)
 - Herning Declaration endorsed in Sept 2025
- Initiating work on a possible European VET diploma / label – to ensure recognition of diplomas/modules/ across countries - pilot projects in 2025-2026 in Erasmus+
- Strengthen Centres of Vocational Excellence in 2026-2029
- Develop joint transnational programmes and short courses leading to MCs in strategic STEM sectors through the CoVEs and Universities Alliances



Status for implementation of Erasmus+ CoVEs

- Indicative budget of 400 million euros to fund 100 projects in the period 2021-2027
- 12 pilot projects were funded in 2019 and 2020.
- All countries from Danube Regions are represented in the E+ CoVEs
- Call of 2025 being evaluated (approx. budget for 15/16 projects)
- 2 more calls coming up in 2026 and 2027
