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#### 1. The Semester cycle

- Follows a specific one-year cycle
- During the first phase, EU member states discuss their fiscal and budgetary plans and agree on key priorities
- In the second part of the cycle, EU member states aim to align national policies for the subsequent year

**IMPLEMENTATION** 

#### 1. The Semester cycle

- Nov.: release of "autumn package" (Documents: Alert Mechanism Report, Annual Sustainable Growth Survey, Joint Employment Report, the draft recommendations on economic policy and the opinions on the budget plans)
- March: approval of "autumn package"
- April: MS submit National Reform Programmes (NRPs) and medium-term fiscal structural plans to be evaluated by the EC
- May: based on the NRPs the EC issues Country Specific Recommendations (CSRs) among other documents with the "spring package"
- June-July: CSRs discussed in the Council, approval in June, adoption in July
- Aug.-Oct.: MS are invited to implement the CSRs

### 2. The role of the Employment Committee (EMCO) in the Semester

- EMCO operates within the policy framework of the European Employment Strategy and as set out in Art. 148 TFEU plays a key role in the European Semester
- Advisory committee to the EPSCO Council
- Promotes the coordination of employment and labour market policies both at European and national level
- Two subgroups: Indicators Group (IG) & Policy Analysis Group (PAG)
- Every year, EMCO adopts its Annual Work Programme, taking into account the policy priorities of the European Council, the Council and the EC
- EMCO cooperates with other committees (especially the Social Protection
   Committee and the Economic Policy Committee) to discuss issues of joint interest
- Tasks: Council advice & opinions, multilateral surveillance & thematic work

#### 3. A practical example: The Social Convergence Framework (SCF)

- Aim: identifying social imbalances occurring in the EU and its member states
- Pilot in 2023-2024
- 2-step analysis:
  - 1. Identifying risks to social convergence through the Social Scoreboard
  - 2. If a MS qualifies: Staff Working Document for 2nd stage deeper analysis
  - MLS & CSR review: If risks to social convergence have been confirmed
