### 24th Steering Group Meeting of Priority Area 9 | 14 June 2023 | online

Participants of our 24<sup>th</sup> Steering Group meeting shared updates on education and labour market developments and opportunities for cooperation in the Danube Region. Our Steering Group also decided on labelling two initiatives as Danube Strategy Flagships: the <u>Education Reform Initiative of South Eastern</u> <u>Europe</u> (ERI SEE) and the initiative behind the annual eTwinning conferences "Bringing the Danube Region Into Classrooms: Promoting Cooperation of Schools and Teachers". # Erasmus+/eTwinning Thematic Conference: "School Cooperation in the Danube Region" | 1-2 June 2023 | Krems, Austria

The latest eTwinning conference "School Cooperation in the Danube Region" brought 43 teachers from 11 Danube Region countries to the town of Krems, Austria. The aim of the event was to connect teachers and schools and to initiate innovative cooperation projects in the region. Ten new eTwinning projects were developed during the conference. The conference was hosted by OeAD, the Austrian National Agency for Erasmus+, in cooperation with Priority Area "People & Skills" and the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research. # Council Conclusions on the 4<sup>th</sup> Report of the European Commission on the Implementation of EU Macro-Regional Strategies

In June 2023, the Council adopted conclusions on the <u>4<sup>th</sup> Report of the</u> <u>European Commission on the Implementation of EU Macro-Regional Strategies</u> in 2020-2021. The <u>Council conclusions</u> highlight the relevance of macro-regional strategies such as the EUSDR in fostering cohesion, regional development and in the context of the green, digital, and socially sustainable transition. Their role in the enlargement process and to support Ukraine and the Republic of Moldova is also emphasised.

### 4<sup>th</sup> EU Macro-Regional Strategies Week | 24-28 April 2023 | Brussels, Belgium + online

The 4<sup>th</sup> EU Macro-Regional Strategies Week was held in Brussels and online from 24-28 April 2023 under the motto "Transform to Thrive". ### Slovenian EUSDR Presidency Conference "Towards Knowledge-Driven Society and Professions of the Future" | 17-18 May 2023 | Brdo, Slovenia + online

The Slovenian EUSDR Presidency conference "Towards Knowledge-Driven Society and Professions of the Future" took place from 17 to 18 May 2023 in Brdo, Slovenia and online. It focused on the importance of knowledge development and adaptions to the changes brought about by the green and digital transitions. ### Involvement of Youth in the EUSDR

The Danube Youth Council, launched in October 2022, consists of 28 members aged 18-29 from all Danube Region countries. It is envisaged to have an advisory role in the governance of the EUSDR. In February 2023, we met with members interested in the work of our Priority Area. A member of the Danube Youth Council also shared inputs during our latest Steering Group meeting. In addition to the Danube Youth Council, the involvement of youth in the EUSDR shall also be promoted through a Danube Youth Organisations Network.
