- · ensuring quality learning outcomes for all
- fostering equal opportunities in education; reducing the number of early school leavers; addressing gender gaps
- strengthening responsiveness of E&T to economic and social needs
- strengthening vocational education and training (VET)
- increasing participation in lifelong learning (LLL)
- · reinforcing basic and key competences
- · fostering green and digital skills
- · quality assurance and skills monitoring
- · promotion of teaching at all levels
- · fostering transparency of skills
- competences to promote the ownership of democratic values and sustainable development.

Excellence in VET for a green and fair transition in the Danube Region



- PA9 Flagship-Initiative: Danube Region Platform on Centres of Vocational Excellence since 2021
- Vocational excellence approaches feature prominently in the EU policy agenda for skills (e.g. Skills Agenda, EEA, Council Recommendation on VET, Osnabrück Declaration)
- VET excellence is a also policy priority in DRCs; EU funding plays a key role in filling gaps and supporting cooperation
- Clear added value in transnational cooperation to promote VET excellence (mutual learning, sharing good practices, peer learning, study visits; E+ projects)
- Greening of VET is policy priority; various sectors in the green economy growing in the region
- Need for new, green occupations and/or greening of existing occupations

Excellence in VET for a green and fair transition in the Danube Region

- SMF: an opportunity to prepare large-scale projects on establishment and development of international collaborative networks of CoVEs in the context of going green and fair.
- Main challenges/needed activities can be clustered into:
 - · teaching and learning
 - cooperation and partnerships
 - · governance and funding
- CoVE-projects to operate at two levels: regional/national and macroregional/international
