The conference is hosted by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine in partnership with the Federal Ministry of Labour and the Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research of the Republic of Austria, the Ukrainian Institute for International Politics, L&R Social Research and OeAD–Austria's Agency for Education and Internationalisation.

#### Background:

The general objective of the conference is to raise the discussion related to the main challenges within the Priority Area 9 (People and Skills). The profound digitalization of education, as well as the labour market and readiness to such transformations, remain to be a central necessity for the EUSDR member states. The issue of digitalization is widely discussed internationally and should be actively and regularly raised in the Danube region.

The conference aims to support the general development of social inclusion within EUSDR countries. Such topics as the problem of early school leavers and involvement of youngsters in education and training are crucial and remain on the discussion list.
