DYN Activities Youth and Cities Ellwangen, Germany

- Sustainable cooperation with municipality of City of Ellwangen since 2017
- 5 annual offline and online events with approx. 50
 participants each from almost all the Danube
 countries
- Goal: to foster the communication and exchange between youth and public sector promoting nonformal und informal education, creativity, intercultural dialogue and linguistic diversity in the Danube region
