HIGHLIGHTS

10-Year Anniversary of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region

In June 2011, the European Council endorsed the EU Strategy for the Danube Region (EUSDR). On the occasion of the 10-year anniversary of the EUSDR implementation, the Danube Strategy Point has published a digital brochure, which also features a contribution from Priority Area 9. Under the title "Where Labour Market and Education Policies Meet Neighbourhood Policy", the text looks at how the EUSDR enables cooperation between EU Member States and non-EU countries on equal terms. This is particularly true for Priority Area 9, where Austria and the Republic of Moldova have been cooperating in the coordination of the Priority Area since 2011 and were joined by Ukraine in 2019. To celebrate the last 10 years, Priority Area 9 is also preparing a dedicated publication with a collection of texts on collaboration in labour market and education policies, as well as on the inclusion of marginalised groups in the Danube Region. The 8th Danube Participation Day was dedicated to "Participation & Digitalisation" and took place online back-to-back with the 10th Annual Forum. The importance of digital skills was one of the topics of the panel discussions and world café sessions.

Priority Area 9 “People & Skills” was invited to contribute to a round table on “The role of youth and youth policies in the EUSDR”. At this occasion, PA9 highlighted the importance of education and labour market policies both when it comes to the participation of youth in the EUSDR’s governance structures and on a more general level when dealing for instance with young people not in education, employment, or training. The audience participated actively and shared their views on pressing issues for young people, useful tools for youth involvement and their visions on the future of the Danube Region.

Start of the Ukrainian EUSDR Presidency | 1 November 2021

Ukraine is the first non-EU country to chair the EU Strategy for the Danube Region from November 2021 to October 2022. The presidency was handed over by Slovakia at the Annual Forum. 21st Steering Group Meeting of Priority Area 9 | 4-5 November 2021 | Online

Kick-off of the Danube Region Platform on Centres of Vocational Excellence | 29 November 2021 | Online

The Danube Region Platform on Centres of Vocational Excellence was launched by Priority Area 9 and the European Training Foundation in an online event on 29 November 2021. The thematic focus of the platform lies on the topics of going green and social inclusion. As part of the initiative, the meeting established a Policy Platform on Centres of Vocational Excellence, bringing together a core group of representatives of responsible national institutions from Danube Region countries and experts from the European Commission, PA9 and ETF. Inputs from Centres of Vocational Excellence active in the areas of going green and inclusive VET provided a basis for the thematic exchange in break-out groups.
