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




## How to get there?

## **Arrival from the Vienna International Airport:**

- Bus VAL1 (Vienna Airport Lines): 40 minutes travel time to the stop "Wien Westbahnhof"; one-way ticket: EUR 8.00 (or EUR 4.00 if you print this <u>voucher</u> and hand it to the driver). Buses only leave once every hour. For the time schedule, please go to <a href="https://www.viennaairportlines.at/en/">https://www.viennaairportlines.at/en/</a>. From "Westbahnhof", it is a 5-minute walk to the venue.
- Trains S7 or REX7: 23 minutes travel time to the stop "Wien Mitte"; one-way ticket: EUR 4.30 (including the onward travel on the public transport system). Ticket machines are located in the airport arrival hall, the passages to the train platforms and on the platforms. Trains leave every 30 minutes during the day. For the time schedule, please go to <a href="https://fahrplan.oebb.at/bin/query.exe/en">https://fahrplan.oebb.at/bin/query.exe/en</a>. From "Wien Mitte", take the underground U3 (direction "Ottakring") to "Westbahnhof". From "Westbahnhof", it is a 5-minute walk to the venue.
- CAT City Airport Train: 16 minutes travel time to the stop "Wien Mitte"; one-way ticket: EUR 12.00. For the time schedule, please go to <a href="https://www.cityairporttrain.com">https://www.cityairporttrain.com</a>. At "Wien Mitte", you need to buy an underground ticket (EUR 2.40 one way) and take the underground (direction "Ottakring") to "Westbahnhof". From "Westbahnhof", it is a 5-minute walk to the venue.

## Parking at and close to the venue:

The Flemings Conference Hotel has a limited number of parking spaces at a garage behind the hotel (entrance at Kenyongasse) (for a fee of EUR 24.00 per day). You can stop briefly at a designated space in front of the hotel and go to the reception to enquire if a parking space is available.

There is also a public garage (at Kenyongasse 25; behind the Arcotel Wimberger Hotel) (for a fee of EUR 25.00 per day).

### Information for participants whose travel costs are covered by the organisers:

Please make sure to hold on to your boarding passes (in case of paper boarding passes). The boarding passes for your trip to Vienna will be collected by the organising team on 9 June. You will be asked to send the boarding passes for your return trip to the organising team by post.

#### **COVID-19 information**

## **Travel to Austria:**

<u>Status as at 23 May 2022</u>: There are currently no COVID-19 restrictions on entering Austria from abroad. Therefore, you no longer need to show proof of vaccination, proof of recovery or a negative COVID-19 test to enter Austria.

## **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Vienna:**

Status as at 23 May 2022: FFP2 masks are mandatory on public transport (including at train stations and airports), when using taxis and in essentials shops (e.g. supermarkets and pharmacies).

## Visa requirements (if applicable)

If applicable, a valid Schengen visa must be obtained before arrival in Austria. Delegates requiring an entry visa must submit their request to the competent Austrian authority at least three weeks before their expected travel date. In general, the competent authority is the Austrian embassy or consulate general in the country of residence of the applicant. It is recommended to consult the website of the embassy or consulate general well ahead of the intended date of travel.
