• What is EuroAccess?

An online search tool which can be used to find potential and available funding possibilities for EU-projects in the Danube Region

• Background:

EUSDR Action Plan – PA10 action 7: *"to review bottlenecks relating to the low absorption rate of EU funds and to ensure better coordination of funding"*

- 2 main reasons of the low absorption rate of EU funds in the Danube Region:
 - no central information point on EU-funds
 - limited knowledge on available EU-funds
- Objective: to facilitate access to EU-Funds and raise the amount of <u>EU-funded projects in the Danube Region</u>









- Management Structure:
 - **PAC10 Vienna** /City of Vienna: Beneficiary of the Commission's grant
 - EuroVienna EU-consulting & -management GmbH: Implementing Body
 - Key competences: Project development / Project management / Financial Management

- Listing Calls for proposals under the European Structural and Investment Programmes (ESI) and Action Programmes relevant to the EUSDR in the funding period 2014-2020
- Covering 7 topics which correspond roughly to the priorities of the European Union in the funding period 2014-2020: environment & climate change, science & research, education & youth & culture, health & sports, employment & social policies, infrastructure & transports, energy

Description of programme "COSME"	COSME is the EU programme for the Competitiveness of Enterprises and Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs) running from 2014 to 2020 with a planned budget of 2.3 bn. €.
	Accessing finance
	COSME aims to make it easier for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) to access finance in all phases of their lifecycle – creation, expansion, or business transfer. Thanks to EU support, businesses have easier access to guarantees, loans and equity capital. EU 'financial instruments' are channelled through local financial institutions in EU countries. To find a financial institution in your country, visit the Access to Finance portal.
	Opening markets
	COSME helps businesses to access markets in the EU and beyond. It funds the Enterprise Europe Network that helps SMEs find business and technology partners, and understand EU legislation; the Your Europe Business portal that provides practical information on doing business within Europe; and the SME Internationalisation Portal for companies who want to develop their activities outside Europe. It also finances a number of IPR (intellectual property rights) SME Helpdesks.
	Supporting entrepreneurs
	COSME supports entrepreneurs by strengthening entrepreneurship education, mentoring, guidance and other support services. Actions support specific groups who may find it difficult to reach their full potential, such as young people, women and senior entrepreneurs. The programme also aims to help businesses access opportunities offered by digital technologies.

	COSME aims to reduce the administrative and regulatory burden on SMEs by creating a business-friendly environment. COSME also supports businesses to be competitive by encouraging them to adopt new business models and innovative practices.
