# Mutual learning through the right:

- Themes:
  - original 8 set by Common Framework (agreed by TNC LN & ESF Committee)
  - Migrants added
  - Impact Task Force created to fill gap
- **People** MAs, policy specialists, stakeholders
- Partnerships EAPN, FEANTSA ...
- **Size** too big → sub-groups (small can work well)

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### Mutual learning through the right:

- **Expertise** many MAs representatives are not policy specialists
- **Connections** experts should bring these
- **Strong co-ordination** try bottom-up agendasetting, but have your own agenda too
- **Lead MS** volunteers / rotating / sub-groups
- **Rhythm** 3 meetings per year
- Individuality within consistent framework
