# Objectives of the project (2)


# LLP Horizontal policies addressed

# Obstacles/ challenges

#### **Obstacles**

- Engage local decision makers on a voluntary basis
- Involve Universities in community service on a voluntary basis
- Adult participation in the Family Literacy programme
- Institutional hypocrisy

#### **Solutions**

- Identify personal relations
- Delegation
- NGO recruiting volunteers
- Incentives, compromise location (community vs school) & time
- Addressing local Roma community center and the city hall (SK)
- Hold them accountable, advocacy
