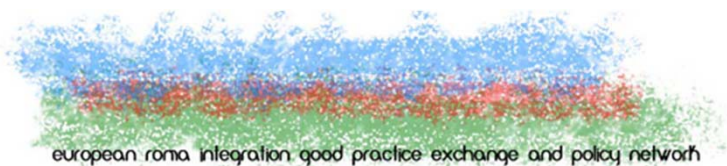

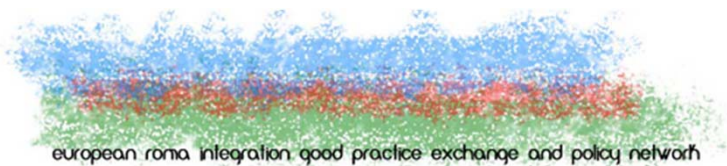

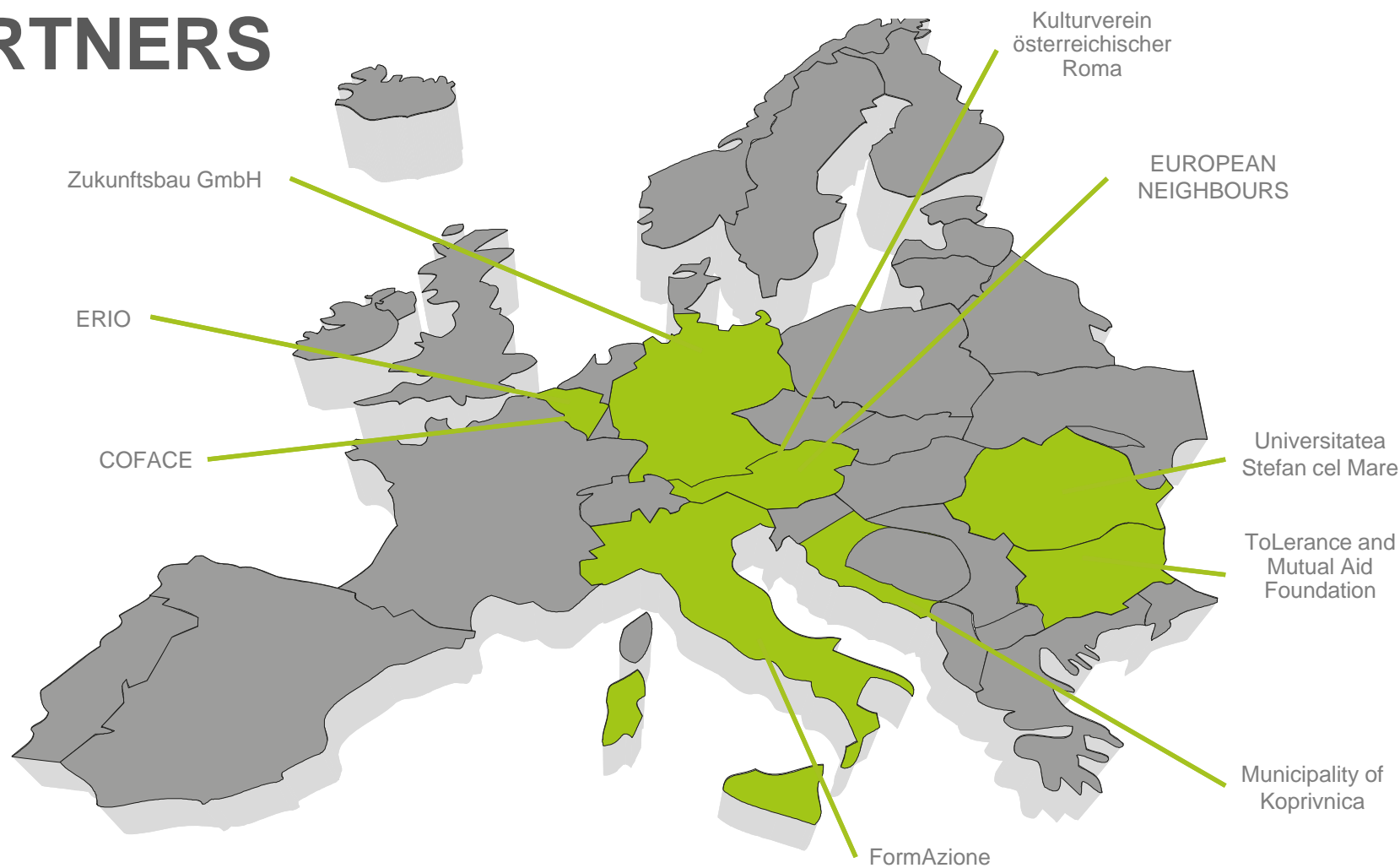


ERNE Project
